As we are planning to hold the OAIA 2022 Conference in person, the 2022 OAIA Conference Planning Committee has taken the following steps:

- ✓ Reduced the number of participants attending in person to facilitate social distancing
- ✓ Reduced the number of participants per table to facilitate social distancing
- ✓ Purchased N95 masks for all in-person attendees to encourage public health best practices with a view to protecting participants who are immuno-compromised
- ✓ Provided for virtual participation for those not comfortable with in-person attendance or in the event they are unable to attend in person
